**AN ACT CONCERNING PERFORMANCE-BASED BUDGETING OF
STATE AGENCIES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 That section 4-67m of the general statutes be amended to require
2 executive branch state agencies to develop and update strategic
3 business plans, including the development of performance measures,
4 and to require the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management to
5 annually report to the General Assembly on the status of the
6 development of such strategic business plans and the specific progress
7 that each state agency has made in carrying out the goals, objectives
8 and performance measures set forth in its strategic business plan, and
9 that section 4-67r of the general statutes be amended to require the
10 Connecticut Progress Council to review the performance of state
11 agencies and quasi-public agencies and make recommendations
12 concerning efficiency, performance and cost savings.

To improve the accountability and performance of state agencies.
