**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR MAXIMIZATION OF FEDERAL FUNDING  
FOR SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioners
- 2 of Social Services and Children and Families to apply for additional
- 3 federal moneys to fund all programs administered by such agencies,
- 4 and to report on or before January 1, 2004, and annually thereafter to
- 5 the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 6 cognizance of matters relating to human services on the status of such
- 7 applications.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require the Commissioners of Social Services and Children and Families to seek additional federal moneys to fund programs within their respective agencies and to file an annual report with the human services committee on the status of such endeavors.
