AN ACT CONCERNING RACIAL PROFILING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 54-1l and 54-1m of the general statutes be repealed.

Statement of Purpose:

To repeal the law pertaining to racial profiling and requiring police departments to record data on all motor vehicle stops.
