***AN ACT CONCERNING HIGHWAY SOUND BARRIERS IN NEIGHBORHOODS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 105 of the general statutes be amended to authorize
- 2 towns to establish special tax districts to raise local revenues to
- 3 provide funding for the cost of highway sound barriers in
- 4 neighborhoods.
