**AN ACT CONCERNING LATERAL OR COMPARATIVE
CERTIFICATION OF POLICE OFFICERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (b) of section 7-294e of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to specify that a candidate for lateral or comparative
- 3 certification need not have completed at least two years of continuous
- 4 service as a certified police officer if such candidate has successfully
- 5 completed the seven-hundred-sixty-hour basic police training
- 6 program, including eighty hours of field training.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow lateral and comparative certification of a police officer who has not completed at least two years of continuous service as a certified police officer if the candidate has successfully completed an approved police basic training program.
