AN ACT CONCERNING STUDENT MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES CALLED TO ACTIVE DUTY DURING A SEMESTER AND COLLEGE COURSE FEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 10a-77 of the general statutes is amended by
2 adding subsection (g) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

3 (NEW) (g) Said board of trustees shall allow any student who is a
4 member of the armed forces called to active duty during any semester
5 to enroll in any course for which such student had remitted tuition but
6 was not completed due to active duty status. Such course reenrollment
7 shall be offered to any qualifying student without additional tuition,
8 student fee or related charge.

9 Sec. 2. Section 10a-99 of the general statutes is amended by adding
10 subsection (h) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

11 (NEW) (h) Said board of trustees shall allow any student who is a
12 member of the armed forces called to active duty during any semester
13 to enroll in any course for which such student had remitted tuition but
14 was not completed due to active duty status. Such course reenrollment

15 shall be offered to any qualifying student without additional tuition,
16 student fee or related charge.

17 Sec. 3. Section 10a-105 of the general statutes is amended by adding
18 subsection (i) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

19 (NEW) (i) Said board of trustees shall allow any student who is a
20 member of the armed forces called to active duty during any semester
21 to enroll in any course for which such student had remitted tuition but
22 was not completed due to active duty status. Such course reenrollment
23 shall be offered to any qualifying student without additional tuition,
24 student fee or related charge.
