AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT JUVENILE TRAINING SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2003*) (a) The Department of
2 Children and Families shall ensure that the Connecticut Juvenile
3 Training School:

4 (1) Completes health, mental health and educational assessments for
5 each child admitted to the school not later than seven days from the
6 date of such child's admission;

7 (2) Completes a written individualized treatment plan for each child
8 admitted to the school not later than thirty days from the date of such
9 child's admission;

10 (3) Complies with the provisions of sections 46a-150 to 46a-154,
11 inclusive, of the general statutes regarding the use of physical
12 restraints, medication and seclusion of children at the school;

13 (4) Provides training to all staff at the school regarding their
14 mandatory child abuse and neglect reporting obligations under section
