**AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY REGARDING DEFIANT, REBELLIOUS  
AND NONDELINQUENT TEENS BETWEEN THE AGES OF THIRTEEN  
AND EIGHTEEN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the General Assembly be required to study the manner in
- 2 which defiant, rebellious and nondelinquent teenagers between
- 3 thirteen and eighteen years of age are served and treated pursuant to
- 4 the general statutes and by relevant state agencies.
