Substitute Bill No. 6270

January Session, 2003

**AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONSERVATION AND LOAD
MANAGEMENT FUND, THE RENEWABLE ENERGY INVESTMENT
FUND AND THE MAPPING OF LONG ISLAND SOUND.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2003*) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions
2 of section 16-245m of the general statutes, the provisions of section 49
3 of house bill 6548 of the current session, and the provisions of section
4 20 of public act 03-2, no moneys shall be transferred from the Energy
5 Conservation and Load Management Fund to the General Fund.

6 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 16-245n of the general
7 statutes and the provisions of section 49 of house bill 6548 of the
8 current session, no moneys shall be transferred from the Renewable
9 Energy Investment Fund to the General Fund in excess of twenty-five
10 per cent of the balance of the Renewable Energy Investment Fund at
11 the beginning of the month for the period of July 1, 2003, to June 30,
12 2005.

13 Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than October 1, 2003, the
14 Department of Environmental Protection shall issue a request for
15 proposals for the performance of the mapping of the floor of Long
16 Island Sound. The department shall publish such request for proposals
17 in one or more newspapers or periodicals, as selected by the
18 department. The department shall enter into a contract for the

19 performance of such mapping with the person that the department
20 determines to be the most qualified of the respondents to the request
21 for proposals. The department shall report the results, in accordance
22 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, of such
23 mapping to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
24 having cognizance of matters relating to the environment not later
25 than January 1, 2005. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 16-
26 245m of the general statutes, not more than five hundred thousand
27 dollars shall be transferred from the Energy Conservation and Load
28 Management Fund, which moneys shall be allocated to the department
29 for administrative costs incurred in issuing the request for proposals
30 pursuant to this section and for the payment for the mapping of the
31 floor of Long Island Sound.

This act shall take effect as follows:
