AN ACT CONCERNING THE POWERS OF THE POLICE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING COUNCIL RELATIVE TO COMPREHENSIVE ACCREDITATION STANDARDS FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT UNITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That subdivision (18) of subsection (a) of section 7-294d of the
2 general statutes be amended to authorize the Police Officer Standards
3 and Training Council to develop, adopt and revise, as necessary,
4 comprehensive accreditation standards for the administration and
5 management of law enforcement units; at the request and expense of
6 any law enforcement unit, to conduct such surveys as may be
7 necessary to determine their compliance with adopted accreditation
8 standards; and to grant accreditation to those law enforcement units
9 which demonstrate their compliance with adopted accreditation
10 standards.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the powers of the Police Officer Standards and Training Council with respect to comprehensive accreditation standards.
