**AN ACT CONCERNING SUPERVISED VISITATION BETWEEN PARENTS AND CHILDREN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) The Chief Court  
2 Administrator shall identify secure visitation centers for the purpose of  
3 facilitating visits between children and those family members who are  
4 subject to supervised visitation. The Chief Court Administrator shall  
5 prepare a list of such secure visitation centers and shall make copies of  
6 such list available to the public at no charge. Such list may include  
7 visitation centers established pursuant to section 17a-101d of the  
8 general statutes for visitation for children in the custody of the  
9 Commissioner of Children and Families.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2003</i>
