***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NEUROFEEDBACK PILOT PROGRAM.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2003*) The Department of Public Health, in  
2 consultation with the Department of Education, shall establish, within  
3 available appropriations, a neurofeedback pilot program for the 2003-  
4 2004 school year for forty students age twelve to fourteen, inclusive.  
5 The pilot program shall operate for a period of one year in a school  
6 district of a town in the ninety-fifth percentile when all towns are  
7 ranked from high to low based on the amount of special education  
8 funding each town receives from the state. Local and regional boards  
9 of education interested in participating in the pilot program shall  
10 apply to the department at such time and in such manner as the  
11 Commissioner of Public Health prescribes. The commissioner shall  
12 report in accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, on the  
13 pilot program to the joint standing committees of the General  
14 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to public health and  
15 education by July 1, 2004.

This act shall take effect as follows:
