AN ACT CONCERNING THE EARLY RETIREMENT INCENTIVE PLAN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 subsection (b) of section 6 of public act 03-2, the effective date of
3 retirement pursuant to said section 6 may be deferred on a case by case
4 basis for: (1) Employees of the Office of the State Treasurer with
5 primary responsibility for the planning and issuance of debt or the in-
6 house short-term investment of state and municipal funds, to not later
7 than June 1, 2004; (2) upon the request of the personnel policies
8 subcommittee of the Joint Committee on Legislative Management,
9 employees of said committee determined to be critical to the legislative
10 process, to not later than December 1, 2003; and (3) upon the request
11 of and consistent with the memorandum of understanding signed by
12 the CORE-CT Steering Committee comprised of the Comptroller, the
13 Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, the Commissioner
14 of Administrative Services and the Director of Information
15 Technology, employees assigned to the CORE-CT project for three or
16 more days per week, or determined to be critical to implementation of

17 the CORE-CT project, to not later than June 1, 2004. Any such
18 employee requested to stay beyond May 31, 2003, who refuses to do so
19 shall continue to be eligible for the ERIP.

20 Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
21 subsection (b) of section 6 of public act 03-2: (1) The provisions of said
22 subsection (b) shall apply to state employees who are members of the
23 Teachers' Retirement System, and (2) the provisions of said subsection
24 (b) shall not be applicable to state employees who are part-time
25 instructors at an institution of higher education.
