AN ACT CONCERNING NONEDUCATOR SUPERINTENDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 10-157 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2003*):

4 (b) A local or regional board of education may appoint as [acting]
5 superintendent a person who is or is not properly certified [for a
6 specified period of time, not to exceed ninety days, with the approval
7 of the Commissioner of Education. Such acting superintendent shall
8 assume all duties of the superintendent for the time specified,
9 provided such period of time may be extended with the approval of
10 the commissioner, which he shall grant for good cause shown] as
11 required by subsection (a) of this section, provided the person has
12 substantial experience in at least two of the following: (1) Management
13 of complex public, private, military, or nonprofit organizations; (2)
14 personnel evaluation and supervision; (3) staff development and
15 human relations; (4) financial management; (5) senior management
16 position involving significant responsibility and accountability to
17 shareholders, employees or the public; or (6) other significant

- 18 leadership achievements that demonstrate that the person is uniquely
19 qualified to serve as superintendent, as determined by the board.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	July 1, 2003

Statement of Purpose:

To allow uncertified persons who possess significant business and leadership experience to serve as superintendent.
