Substitute Bill No. 6675

January Session, 2003

AN ACT CONCERNING NONEDUCATOR SUPERINTENDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 10-157 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2003*):

4 (b) A local or regional board of education may appoint as [acting]
5 superintendent a person who is or is not properly certified [for a
6 specified period of time, not to exceed ninety days, with the approval
7 of the Commissioner of Education. Such acting superintendent shall
8 assume all duties of the superintendent for the time specified,
9 provided such period of time may be extended with the approval of
10 the commissioner, which he shall grant for good cause shown] as
11 required by subsection (a) of this section, provided, if the person is not
12 properly certified, the person has substantial experience in at least two
13 of the following: (1) Management of complex public, private, military,
14 or nonprofit organizations; (2) personnel evaluation and supervision;
15 (3) staff development and human relations; (4) financial management;
16 (5) senior management position involving significant responsibility
17 and accountability to shareholders, employees or the public; or (6)
18 other significant leadership achievements that demonstrate that the
19 person is uniquely qualified to serve as superintendent, as determined
20 by the board.
