AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAL SAVINGS ACCOUNTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (f) of section 38a-493 of the general statutes and
- 2 subsection (f) of section 38a-520 of the general statutes be amended to
- 3 exempt high deductible health insurance policies used to establish
- 4 federally qualified medical savings accounts from the fifty dollar
- 5 maximum home health care deductible required in certain health
- 6 insurance policies.

Statement of Purpose:

To permit the sale of federally-qualified medical savings accounts in this state by exempting such accounts from certain insurance deductible requirements.
