AN ACT VALIDATING RESULTS OF A REFERENDUM IN THE TOWN OF WOODBURY CONCERNING THE ACQUISITION AND IMPROVEMENT BY THE TOWN OF LAND AND A BUILDING FOR USE AS TOWN OFFICES AND FACILITIES AND A SENIOR CENTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any provision of
2 the general statutes or of any special act, charter or ordinance, the vote
3 cast by the electors and voters of the town of Woodbury at the
4 referendum held on July 30, 2002, relating to approval of and an
5 appropriation for acquisition of a certain parcel of land and of a certain
6 easement, and for certain building renovations and improvements in
7 connection with the provision of town offices and facilities and a
8 senior center, and the appropriation of funds and the authorization of
9 the issuance of bonds, notes and temporary notes and the acceptance
10 of grants to defray said appropriation, otherwise valid except for the
11 failure to publish and post notice of said referendum, are validated.
12 All acts, votes and proceedings of the officers and officials of the town
13 of Woodbury pertaining to or taken in reliance on said referendum,
14 otherwise valid except for the failure to publish and post notice of said

15 referendum, are validated and effective as of the date taken.

This act shall take effect as follows:
