AN ACT EXEMPTING CERTAIN MINOR SHEET METAL WORK FROM LICENSING REQUIREMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That section 20-340 of the general statutes be amended to exempt
2 from licensing requirements sheet metal work performed in residential
3 buildings consisting of six units or less by new home construction
4 contractors, home improvement contractors and persons licensed
5 under chapter 393 of the general statutes, where such work is limited
6 to exhaust systems normally installed for kitchen bath hoods and fans,
7 clothes dryer exhaust systems, radon vent systems or the installation of
8 other stand alone appliances, but not including wood, pellet or other
9 stand-alone stoves that are normally installed in residential buildings
10 by such contractors or persons.

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt certain tradespersons who perform minor sheet metal work from licensing requirements.
