**AN ACT CONCERNING UNION REPRESENTATION AT DCF
INVESTIGATIVE MEETINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow any employee who
- 2 works with children and is a member of an employee organization or
- 3 association to have a representative of such organization or association
- 4 present whenever the employee is required to participate in an
- 5 investigative meeting with the Department of Children and Families.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow employees who work with children to have union representation whenever they are required to participate in an investigative meeting with the Department of Children and Families.
