***AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TRACKING PROCEDURE FOR THE
REMAINS OF DECEASED PERSONS UNTIL INTERMENT.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-64 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Commissioner of Public Health to adopt regulations, in accordance
- 3 with the provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, for the
- 4 purpose of establishing a procedure for following the transfer and
- 5 movement of the body of each person who dies in this state from the
- 6 time of death until such time as the body is buried, removed or
- 7 cremated.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a tracking procedure for the remains of persons who die in this state.
