**AN ACT CONCERNING THE GRAVE SITES OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND
MILITARY PERSONNEL KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to established a coordinated
- 2 state and local program for the identification, repair and maintenance
- 3 of grave sites, memorial markers and monuments honoring
- 4 servicemen and women who have been killed in the line of duty since
- 5 the state's organization as a colony, including (1) state and local police
- 6 officers, constables, deputies and similar officials, (2) professional and
- 7 volunteer firefighters, and (3) military personnel regardless of rank or
- 8 branch of service.

Statement of Purpose:

To honor public safety and military personnel who have been killed in the line of duty by ensuring that their grave sites are properly identified, maintained and cared for.
