AN ACT CONCERNING THE REWARD FOR INFORMATION REGARDING THE THEFT OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE, LIVESTOCK OR POULTRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2003*) Section 54-51 of the general
- 2 statutes is repealed.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>October 1, 2003</i>

Statement of Purpose:

To repeal unused statutory provisions concerning the reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person for the theft of any motor vehicle, mule, ass, cattle, horse or poultry.
