



AN ACT CONCERNING BOILERS AND HOT WATER HEATERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 29-231 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

3 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to: (1) Boilers under
4 federal control; (2) portable boilers used in pumping, heating,
5 steaming and drilling in the open field; (3) portable boilers used solely
6 for agricultural purposes; (4) [boilers on steam fire engines brought
7 into the state for temporary use in checking conflagrations; (5)] steam
8 heating boilers, [carrying a pressure of not more than fifteen pounds
9 per square inch, when used in private homes or apartment houses of
10 not more than five families, provided they are equipped with adequate
11 safety devices; (6) hot water heating boilers carrying a pressure of not
12 more than thirty pounds per square inch] hot water heaters and hot
13 water heating boilers, when used in private homes or apartment
14 houses of not more than five families; [, provided they are equipped
15 with adequate safety devices; (7) boilers installed and inspected under
16 any city, town or borough system of boiler inspection under standards
17 equivalent to those established under the provisions of this chapter;
18 (8)] (5) hot water heaters approved by a nationally recognized testing
19 agency [which] that are equipped with adequate safety devices
20 including a temperature and pressure relief valve, having a nominal
21 water capacity of not more than one hundred twenty gallons and a
