AN ACT CONCERNING THE BENEFICIAL REUSE OF GLASS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 22a-208z of the general statutes is repealed and
2 the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) An owner or operator of a solid waste facility, as defined in
4 section 22a-207, may use crushed recycled glass as cover material, as
5 defined in the regulations adopted pursuant to section 22a-209.

6 (b) A person may use crushed recycled glass as fill material,
7 including, but not limited to, bedding for asphalt, concrete, or a
8 drainage system, or any other use in which such glass would serve as a
9 substitute for sand or stone aggregate.

This act shall take effect as follows:

To allow crushed recycled glass to be used as fill material.
