AN ACT CONCERNING PROCESS PIPING USED TO PRODUCE PRODUCTS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (3) of section 20-330 of the general statutes, as
2 amended by section 1 of public act 02-27 and section 1 of public act 02-
3 92, is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
4 *October 1, 2003*):

5 (3) "Plumbing and piping work" means the installation, repair,
6 replacement, alteration or maintenance of gas, water and associated
7 fixtures, laboratory equipment, sanitary equipment, other than
8 subsurface sewage disposal systems, fire prevention apparatus, all
9 water systems for human usage, sewage treatment facilities and all
10 associated fittings within a building and includes lateral storm and
11 sanitary lines from buildings to the mains, process piping used to
12 produce a product for human consumption, swimming pools and
13 pumping equipment, and includes making connections to back flow
14 prevention devices, and includes low voltage wiring, not exceeding
15 twenty-four volts, used within a lawn sprinkler system, but does not
16 include (A) solar work, except for the repair of those portions of a solar

17 hot water heating system that include the basic domestic hot water
18 tank and the tie-in to the potable water system, (B) the installation,
19 repair, replacement, alteration or maintenance of fire prevention
20 apparatus within a structure, except for standpipes that are not
21 connected to sprinkler systems, and (C) medical gas and vacuum
22 systems work.

23 Sec. 2. Subdivision (5) of section 20-330 of the general statutes, as
24 amended by section 1 of public act 02-27 and section 1 of public act 02-
25 92, is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
26 *October 1, 2003*):

27 (5) "Heating, piping and cooling work" means (A) the installation,
28 repair, replacement, maintenance or alteration of any apparatus for
29 piping, appliances, devices or accessories for heating systems,
30 including sheet metal work, and (B) the installation, repair,
31 replacement, maintenance or alteration of air conditioning and
32 refrigeration systems, boilers, including apparatus and piping for the
33 generation or conveyance of steam and associated pumping
34 equipment and process piping used to produce a product for human
35 consumption. Heating, piping and cooling work does not include solar
36 work or medical gas and vacuum systems work.

This act shall take effect as follows:
