"AN ACT CONCERNING THE SUSPENSION OF MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSES."

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof and renumber the remaining section accordingly:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) (a) No person whose
4 operator's license or right to operate a motor vehicle in this state has
5 been suspended pursuant to section 14-140 of the general statutes for
6 failure to appear for any scheduled court appearance shall operate any
7 motor vehicle during the period of such suspension.

8 (b) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (a) of this
9 section shall, for a first offense, be fined not less than one hundred fifty
10 dollars nor more than two hundred dollars or imprisoned not more
11 than ninety days, or both, and, for any subsequent offense, be fined not
12 less than two hundred dollars nor more than six hundred dollars or
13 imprisoned not more than one year, or both.

14 Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 14-215 of the general statutes is

15 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
16 *October 1, 2003*):

17 (a) No person to whom an operator's license has been refused, or,
18 except as provided in section 1 of this act, whose operator's license or
19 right to operate a motor vehicle in this state has been suspended or
20 revoked, shall operate any motor vehicle during the period of such
21 refusal, suspension or revocation. No person shall operate or cause to
22 be operated any motor vehicle, the registration of which has been
23 refused, suspended or revoked, or any motor vehicle, the right to
24 operate which has been suspended or revoked."
