"AN ACT CONCERNING THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 30-89 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2003*):

6 (b) Any minor who possesses any alcoholic liquor [on any street or
7 highway or in any public place or place open to the public, including
8 any club which is open to the public,] shall be fined not less than two
9 hundred nor more than five hundred dollars. The provisions of this
10 subsection shall not apply to (1) a person over age eighteen who is an
11 employee or permit holder under section 30-90a and who possesses
12 alcoholic liquor in the course of [his] such person's employment or
13 business, (2) a minor who possesses alcoholic liquor on the order of a
14 practicing physician, or (3) a minor who possesses alcoholic liquor
15 while accompanied by a parent, guardian or spouse, who has attained

16 the age of twenty-one."
