"AN ACT CONCERNING IN-STATE TUITION AT STATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) The Ballard Institute and
4 Museum of Puppetry at The University of Connecticut shall be
5 designated the State Museum of Puppetry. Said museum shall collect,
6 preserve and research works of puppetry and puppet theater and
7 prepare public exhibits at the museum and educational exhibits and
8 programs that may be used by institutions of higher education, public
9 and nonpublic schools, libraries, appropriate state agencies or other
10 public institutions.

11 Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the general statutes is
12 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
13 *October 1, 2003*):

14 (NEW) (47) The Governor shall proclaim April twenty-sixth of each
15 year to be "Frederick Law Olmstead Day" to honor his legacy as the
16 founder of American landscape architecture. Suitable exercises shall be
17 held in the State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for
18 the observance of the day."
