40 from the Hamden/North Haven town line northerly to SR 720 shall be

43 Sec. 504. (*Effective from passage*) Route 5 in the town of North Haven
44 from SR 720 northerly to Route 22 shall be designated the "VFW Post
45 10128 Memorial Highway".

46 Sec. 505. (*Effective from passage*) Route 190 from the Suffield/Enfield
47 town line easterly to Elm Street shall be designated the "Sergeant Elijah
48 Churchill Memorial Highway".

49 Sec. 506. (*Effective from passage*) Route 108 in the town of Trumbull
50 from the Stratford/Trumbull town line northerly to SR 711 shall be
51 designated the "Trooper Ernest Morse Memorial Highway".

52 Sec. 507. (*Effective from passage*) Route 173 in the town of West
53 Hartford from SR 529 northerly to the junction for Route 4 shall be
54 designated the "Trooper Carl P. Moller Memorial Highway".

55 Sec. 508. Section 13b-103 of the general statutes is amended by
56 adding subsection (e) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

57 (e) Any person, other than an operator who has received a permit,
58 who holds him or herself out to be a motor vehicle in livery service
59 with the intent to obtain a benefit or to injure or defraud another shall
60 be guilty of a class B misdemeanor."
