**"AN ACT CONCERNING A PILOT PROGRAM OF
NEUROFEEDBACK THERAPY."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioners of Education
4 and Public Health shall, within available appropriations, evaluate the
5 value, efficacy and cost of neurofeedback in the treatment of attention
6 deficit hyperactivity disorder or other identifiable learning disabilities
7 in children who are eligible for special education and related services.
8 The evaluation shall include a survey of scientific literature and
9 consultation with appropriate experts in child development, child
10 psychology, special education and other relevant fields, including, but
11 not limited to, experts affiliated with The University of Connecticut,
12 The University of Connecticut Health Center, Connecticut Children's
13 Hospital and the Yale Child Development Center. The commissioners

14 shall report their findings and recommendations, in accordance with
15 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint
16 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
17 matters relating to education and public health by February 1, 2004."
