**"AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEE CONTRACTS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding the provisions  
4 of section 1 of this act, the pharmacy copay plan shall require a copay  
5 of ten dollars for generics, fifteen dollars for preferred brand names  
6 and twenty dollars for all other prescriptions.

7 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of this act, the health  
8 insurance contribution of each state employee shall be increased by an  
9 amount equal to 5% of the state's cost for such employee's form of  
10 health care coverage.

11 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The sum of \$15,000,000 is  
12 appropriated to the Mashantucket Pequot and Mohegan Fund Grant,  
13 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, for Grants to Towns.

14 (b) The sum of \$15,000,000 is appropriated to the Mashantucket  
15 Pequot and Mohegan Fund Grant, for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
16 2005, for Grants to Towns.

17 (c) The sum of \$7,000,000 is appropriated to the Office of Policy and  
18 Management, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June  
19 30, 2004, for P.I.L.O.T.-New Manufacturing Machinery and  
20 Equipment.

21 (d) The sum of \$7,000,000 is appropriated to the Office of Policy and  
22 Management, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June  
23 30, 2005, for P.I.L.O.T.-New Manufacturing Machinery and  
24 Equipment.

25 (e) The sum of \$2,700,000 is appropriated to the Office of Policy and  
26 Management, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June  
27 30, 2004, for Property Tax Relief for Veterans.

28 (f) The sum of \$2,600,000 is appropriated to the Office of Policy and  
29 Management, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June  
30 30, 2005, for Property Tax Relief for Veterans."
