**"AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEE CONTRACTS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of  
4 section 1 of this act, the pharmacy copay plan shall require a copay of  
5 ten dollars for generics, fifteen dollars for preferred brand names and  
6 twenty dollars for all other prescriptions, and the copay for a visit to a  
7 doctor shall be increased by fifteen dollars.

8 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The sum of \$15,600,000 is  
9 appropriated to the Department of Education, from the General Fund,  
10 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, for education equalization  
11 grants described in section 10-262h of the general statutes.

12 (b) The sum of \$16,200,000 is appropriated to the Department of  
13 Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
14 2005, for education equalization grants described in section 10-262h of

15 the general statutes.

16 (c) The sum of \$1,200,000 is appropriated to the Department of  
17 Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
18 2004, for special education excess cost grants described in section 10-  
19 76g of the general statutes.

20 (d) The sum of \$1,200,000 is appropriated to the Department of  
21 Education, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
22 2005, for special education excess cost grants described in section 10-  
23 76g of the general statutes."
