8 with whom the recipient does not have an established business
9 relationship and electronic mail does not have "unsolicited advertising
10 material" if the sender has the consent of the recipient to receive such
11 mail, or if the sender has a prior or existing business relationship
12 formed by voluntary communication between the sender and the
13 recipient with or without an exchange of consideration, on the basis of
14 an inquiry, application, purchase or use by the recipient regarding
15 products or services offered by the sender."
