**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT
OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (2) of section 12-408 of the general statutes is
4 amended by adding subparagraph (D) as follows (*Effective from passage*
5 *and applicable to sales occurring on or after April 1, 2003*):

6 (NEW) (D) In the case of a sale by a producer or wholesaler of
7 newspapers to a vendor who is not otherwise required to obtain a
8 permit under this chapter, such producer or wholesaler shall collect
9 the sales tax on such newspapers at the point of transfer to such
10 vendor. Such tax shall be based on the stated retail price of such
11 newspapers. Such vendor may add an amount to the price of the
12 newspapers equal to the amount paid as sales tax to the producer or

13 wholesaler and such vendor shall not be required to remit such
14 amount to the state."
