**"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR REVISIONS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION PROVISIONS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The assessment of  
4 administrative costs and the accrual of interest on the actual cost  
5 pursuant to section 22a-451 of the general statutes shall be stayed for  
6 one year from the date such costs and expenses are sought from the  
7 party responsible for such pollution, contamination or emergency for  
8 any person who: (1) Owns property on which a residential dwelling is  
9 located from which lead paint was removed by the Department of  
10 Environmental Protection after January 1, 2002, and prior to December  
11 31, 2002; and (2) hired a licensed contractor to perform such removal."
