**"AN ACT AUTHORIZING MULTIJURISDICTIONAL LOTTERY GAMES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 12-812 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
5 *October 1, 2003*) :

6 (a) (1) The president of the corporation, subject to the direction of  
7 the board, shall conduct daily, weekly, multistate, special instant or  
8 other lottery games and shall determine the number of times a lottery  
9 shall be held each year, the form and price of the tickets and the  
10 aggregate amount of prizes, which shall not be less than forty-five per  
11 cent of the sales unless required by the terms of any agreement entered  
12 into for the conduct of multistate lottery games. The proceeds of the  
13 sale of tickets shall be deposited in the lottery fund of the corporation  
14 from which prizes shall be paid, upon vouchers signed by the

15 president, or by either of two persons designated and authorized by  
16 [him] the president, in such numbers and amounts as the president  
17 determines. The corporation may limit its liability in games with fixed  
18 payouts and may cause a cessation of sales of tickets of certain  
19 designation when such liability limit has been reached.

20 (2) The president shall extend the time period for presenting a valid  
21 prize claim to the corporation by an additional seventy-two hours for  
22 any lottery game expiring on or after July 1, 1996. If the time extension  
23 provided in this subdivision results in the presentation of a valid prize  
24 claim to the corporation, any prize money awarded on that claim shall  
25 be subject to a penalty which subtracts ten per cent of the total from  
26 the prize to be awarded. Any such penalty shall be remitted to the  
27 Commissioner of Revenue Services for deposit into the General Fund.  
28 The authority granted to the president under this subdivision shall  
29 terminate ninety days after the effective date of this section."
