**"AN ACT CONCERNING OUT-OF-STATE COSMETICIAN  
LICENSES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 20-252 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

5 No person shall engage in the occupation of registered hairdresser  
6 and cosmetician without having obtained a license from the  
7 department. Persons desiring such licenses shall apply in writing on  
8 forms furnished by the department. No license shall be issued, except a  
9 renewal of a license, to a registered hairdresser and cosmetician unless  
10 the applicant has shown to the satisfaction of the department that the  
11 applicant has complied with the laws and the regulations administered  
12 or adopted by the department. No applicant shall be licensed as a  
13 registered hairdresser and cosmetician, except by renewal of a license,  
14 until the applicant has made written application to the department,

15 setting forth by affidavit that the applicant has: [successfully] (1)  
16 Successfully completed the eighth grade or has passed an equivalency  
17 examination, evidencing such education, prepared by the  
18 Commissioner of Education and conducted by the Department of  
19 Public Health; [and that the applicant has] (2) completed a course of  
20 not less than fifteen hundred hours of study in a school approved in  
21 accordance with the provisions of this chapter or in a school teaching  
22 hairdressing and cosmetology under the supervision of the State Board  
23 of Education or has successfully completed an apprenticeship program  
24 for hairdressers and cosmeticians of not less than two years; and (3)  
25 until the applicant has passed a written examination satisfactory to the  
26 department. Examinations required for licensure under this chapter  
27 shall be prescribed by the department with the advice and assistance of  
28 the board and shall be administered by the department under the  
29 supervision of the board. The department shall establish a passing  
30 score for examinations with the advice and assistance of the board  
31 which shall be the same as the passing score established in section 20-  
32 236."
