RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO PROCUREMENT REQUESTS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (b) of section 1-213 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2003*):

6 (b) Nothing in the Freedom of Information Act shall be deemed in
7 any manner to:

8 (1) Affect the status of judicial records as they existed prior to
9 October 1, 1975, nor to limit the rights of litigants, including parties to
10 administrative proceedings, under the laws of discovery of this state;
11 [or]

12 (2) Require disclosure of any record of a personnel search committee
13 which, because of name or other identifying information, would reveal

14 the identity of an executive level employment candidate without the
15 consent of such candidate; or

16 (3) Require any individual to transcribe an electronic voice-mail
17 message."
