1 In line 19, after "officers", insert "and persons designated by the
2 Attorney General or the Attorney General's designee to represent such
3 agencies, boards, departments or commissions pursuant to subdivision
4 (5) of this subsection"

5 In line 24, strike "and"

6 In line 27, after "action", insert ", and (D) complete ten hours of
7 training provided by the Commission on Human Rights and
8 Opportunities and the Permanent Commission on the Status of
9 Women pursuant to subdivision (3) of this subsection"

10 Strike section 2 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

11 "Sec. 2. (*Effective from passage*) The Permanent Commission on the
12 Status of Women, in consultation with the Commission on Human
13 Rights and Opportunities, shall conduct a study of women in
14 nontraditional employment, as defined in subsection (a) of section 31-

15 11s of the general statutes, within state agencies. The study shall
16 include, but not be limited to, an assessment of the challenges and
17 barriers to women in such nontraditional employment and a review of
18 employment practices that affect the status of women in such
19 nontraditional employment. Not later than July 1, 2004, the Permanent
20 Commission on the Status of Women shall submit a report of its
21 findings and recommendations to the joint standing committees of the
22 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor and
23 public employees and judiciary, in accordance with the provisions of
24 section 11-4a of the general statutes."
