"AN ACT ALLOWING THE USE OF FLASHING RED OR WHITE LIGHTS ON MOTOR VEHICLES OF FIRE CHIEFS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 14-286e of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *October 1, 2003*):

6 (a) A police officer, firefighter or emergency medical technician
7 operating a bicycle in response to an emergency call or while engaged
8 in rescue operations or in the immediate pursuit of an actual or
9 suspected violator of the law shall be exempt from the provisions of
10 sections 14-286, 14-286a, 14-286b, 14-286c and 14-289 provided (1) the
11 police officer, firefighter or emergency medical technician is wearing a
12 distinctive uniform, and (2) [the police officer] such person has
13 completed a course of instruction in basic police bicycle patrol certified
14 by the Police Officer Standards and Training Council or an equivalent

15 course of instruction."
