**"AN ACT CONCERNING RADIOGRAPHERS AND
ACUPUNCTURISTS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective October 1, 2003*) (a) Notwithstanding the
4 provisions of sections 20-250 to 20-265, inclusive, of the general
5 statutes, during the period from October 1, 2003, to October 31, 2003,
6 inclusive, the Department of Public Health shall issue, without
7 examination, a license as a hairdresser and cosmetician under chapter
8 387 of the general statutes to any applicant who presents to the
9 department satisfactory evidence that such applicant: (1) Has not less
10 than two years of professional experience as a hairdresser or
11 cosmetologist; (2) is licensed as a hairdresser or cosmetician in any
12 other state of the United States, the District of Columbia,
13 commonwealth or territory subject to the law of the United States; (3)

14 is not the subject of a pending professional disciplinary action and has
15 no unresolved professional complaints; and (4) certifies under oath
16 that such applicant is free from communicable diseases.

17 (b) An application submitted pursuant to this section shall be
18 accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars. Any license issued pursuant to
19 this section shall be renewable annually in accordance with the
20 provisions of section 20-253 of the general statutes."
