**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF ELECTRIC  
PERSONAL ASSISTIVE MOBILITY DEVICES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) In the event the  
4 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles issues a motor vehicle operator's  
5 license in accordance with the provisions of section 14-36 of the general  
6 statutes or an identity card in accordance with the provisions of section  
7 1-1h of the general statutes to any person who is a resident of this state  
8 and not a citizen of the United States and whose presence in the United  
9 States is of limited duration, in accordance with any provision of  
10 federal law, the commissioner shall issue such motor vehicle operator's  
11 license or identity card for a limited term to coincide with the period of  
12 such person's lawful presence in this state. Any person who has been

13 issued a motor vehicle operator's license or identity card under this  
14 section who is granted an extension of stay in this state or who obtains  
15 permanent resident status in this state may request, and the  
16 commissioner shall, upon presentation of evidence satisfactory to the  
17 commissioner, surrender of the document that has been issued and  
18 payment of the fee of ten dollars, issue to such person another motor  
19 vehicle operator's license or identity card bearing the new expiration  
20 date of lawful presence in this state. The fee for any motor vehicle  
21 operator's license issued for a limited term shall be nine dollars per  
22 year or any part thereof."
