"AN ACT AMENDING CAMPAIGN FINANCE LAWS CONCERNING DELEGATES TO A UNITED STATES SENATORIAL OR CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT CONVENTION, REGISTRATION AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS, JOINT CAMPAIGN FUND-RAISING EVENTS AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENDITURES MADE BY ONE CANDIDATE COMMITTEE FOR ANOTHER CANDIDATE COMMITTEE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 16-331a of the general statutes is amended by
4 adding subsection (o) as follows:

5 (NEW) (o) Each community antenna television company or
6 nonprofit organization providing community access operations shall
7 provide free broadcast time to each local candidate. Such free
8 broadcast time shall not exceed a total of sixty minutes per candidate
9 and no candidate shall be entitled to receive free broadcast time from
10 more than one company or organization. As used in this section, "local

11 candidate" means a candidate for an office of a municipality in the
12 franchise area of the company or organization, or a candidate for state
13 representative or state senator of a district served by the franchise
14 area."
