**"AN ACT AUTHORIZING DERRICK BETTON TO BRING A CIVIL ACTION AGAINST THE COMMISSIONER OF TRANSPORTATION."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The written notice dated February 5,  
4 2003, and filed with the clerk of the town of East Hampton concerning  
5 injuries allegedly sustained by Christina Rosadini on December 20,  
6 1999, otherwise valid except that said notice of said injuries and a  
7 general description of the same, and of the cause thereof and of the  
8 time and place of their occurrence, was not given to the clerk of the  
9 town of East Hampton within ninety days after their occurrence as  
10 required by section 13a-149 of the general statutes, is validated and  
11 declared sufficient to permit said Christina Rosadini to maintain and  
12 prosecute to final judgment an action against the town of East  
13 Hampton. Said notice shall have the same force and effect as though  
14 the provisions of section 13a-149 of the general statutes concerning the  
15 time within which written notice is required to be given had been

16 complied with and the town of East Hampton shall be barred from  
17 setting up the failure to comply with the provisions of said section 13a-  
18 149 concerning the time within which written notice is required to be  
19 given as a defense to such action and shall also be barred from denying  
20 that notice of such injuries had been given to said town within the time  
21 required."
