**"AN ACT CONCERNING RADIOGRAPHERS AND  
ACUPUNCTURISTS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective October 1, 2003*) (a) Notwithstanding the  
4 provisions of sections 20-250 to 20-265, inclusive, of the general  
5 statutes, during the period from October 1, 2003, to October 31, 2003,  
6 inclusive, the Department of Public Health shall issue, without  
7 examination, a license as a hairdresser and cosmetician under chapter  
8 387 of the general statutes to any applicant who presents to the  
9 department satisfactory evidence that such applicant: (1) Has not less  
10 than two years of professional experience as a hairdresser or  
11 cosmetologist; (2) is licensed as a hairdresser or cosmetician in any  
12 other state of the United States, the District of Columbia,  
13 commonwealth or territory subject to the law of the United States; and

14 (3) is not the subject of a pending professional disciplinary action and  
15 has no unresolved professional complaints.

16 (b) An application submitted pursuant to this section shall be  
17 accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars. Any license issued pursuant to  
18 this section shall be renewable annually in accordance with the  
19 provisions of section 20-253 of the general statutes."
