**"AN ACT CONCERNING INTEREST ON FRAUDULENT
UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION OVERPAYMENTS AND A FEE
FOR FAILURE BY CONTRIBUTING EMPLOYERS TO FILE TIMELY
UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION QUARTERLY RETURNS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (13) of subsection (a) of section 31-236 of the
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

6 (13) If the administrator finds that, having been sentenced to a term
7 of imprisonment of [thirty days or longer] more than seventy-two
8 hours and having commenced serving such sentence, the individual
9 has been discharged or suspended prior to or during such period of
10 imprisonment, then for the period of such imprisonment and until
11 such individual has earned at least ten times such individual's benefit
12 rate."
