**"AN ACT ADDRESSING THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR
SHORTAGE."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 10-157 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
5 *1, 2003*):

6 (b) A local or regional board of education may appoint as [acting]
7 superintendent a person who is or is not properly certified [for a
8 specified period of time, not to exceed ninety days, with the approval
9 of the Commissioner of Education. Such acting superintendent shall
10 assume all duties of the superintendent for the time specified,
11 provided such period of time may be extended with the approval of
12 the commissioner, which he shall grant for good cause shown] as
13 required by subsection (a) of this section, provided, if the person is not

14 properly certified, the person has substantial experience in at least two
15 of the following: (1) Management of complex public, private, military,
16 or nonprofit organizations; (2) personnel evaluation and supervision;
17 (3) staff development and human relations; (4) financial management;
18 (5) senior management position involving significant responsibility
19 and accountability to shareholders, employees or the public; or (6)
20 other significant leadership achievements that demonstrate that the
21 person is uniquely qualified to serve as superintendent, as determined
22 by the board."
