**"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO CERTAIN DEPARTMENT
OF PUBLIC HEALTH STATUTES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 19a-302 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

5 If at any time such association fails to comply with the provisions of
6 section 19a-301, the selectmen of the town in which such cemetery is
7 located shall take over the care of said fund and file an annual report
8 with the Probate Court in accordance with the provisions of section
9 19a-301. The selectmen may appoint a cemetery committee consisting
10 of [~~three~~] seven members, residents of such town, [~~one~~] two to serve
11 for a term of two years, [~~one~~] two for four years and [~~one~~] three for six
12 years, and biennially thereafter they may appoint one member for a
13 term of six years to replace [~~the~~] each member whose term expires.
14 Said committee shall have all of the powers and duties of a committee

15 established as provided in section 19a-301."
