**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE TRANSCRIPTION OF VOICE-MAIL
MESSAGES UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 1-228 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2003*):

5 The public agency may adjourn any regular or special meeting to a
6 time and place specified in the order of adjournment. Less than a
7 quorum may so adjourn from time to time. If all members are absent
8 from any regular meeting the clerk or the secretary of such body may
9 declare the meeting adjourned to a stated time and place and shall
10 cause a written notice of the adjournment to be given in the same
11 manner as provided in section 1-225, for special meetings, unless such
12 notice is waived as provided for special meetings. [A copy of the order
13 or notice of adjournment shall be conspicuously posted on or near the
14 door of the place where the regular or special meeting was held, within

15 twenty-four hours after the time of the adjournment.] When an order
16 of adjournment of any meeting fails to state the hour at which the
17 adjourned meeting is to be held, it shall be held at the hour specified
18 for regular meetings, by ordinance, resolution, by law or other rule."
