**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO FUND  
ANTILITTER PROGRAMS IN THE CITY OF HARTFORD."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2003*) The Commissioner of  
4 Consumer Protection shall adopt regulations, in accordance with the  
5 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, to require that each  
6 meat, poultry or fish product sold at retail for human consumption  
7 contain a packaging label that indicates the date by which such  
8 product must be sold in order to ensure the freshness of the product  
9 and the safety of consumers. Such regulations shall prohibit retailers  
10 from altering or repackaging such products in a manner that obscures  
11 or obliterates such date or extends such date placed on the product  
12 packaging by the manufacturer of the product."
